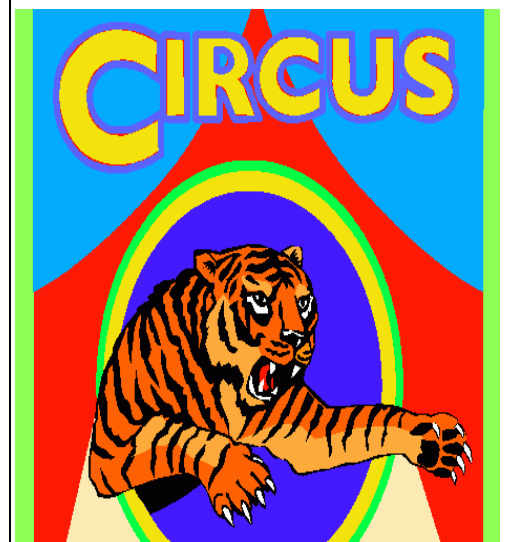

Opportunities Beyond the Budget

Several nobles have questioned me as to why it seems that the Board of Directors (Divan) is always asking for money. I would

like to give my explanation to the nobility the reason for requests.

Hadi is operating under a very tight budget. The decrease in membership has resulted in the loss of funding. Opportunities sometimes arise that were not budgeted and funding is not available to support these projects. Thus, it is necessary for us to seek funding from units, clubs, organizations, and individuals. As a member of the Board it is very important to consider opportunities that will benefit Hadi.

A prime example of a recent opportunity involved the purchase of catering supplies from the Executive Inn. We were able to purchase tables, chairs, a stage, and other items for pennies on the dollar which will improve Hadi's catering capabilities and reduce rental costs for events. Hadi's expense was around \$5,000 for this opportunity.

During the last month the Divan has visited many UCO's to ask for funds to help cover this expense. Several groups and individuals have been generous with their donation to the cause. Total donations of \$2,500 have been received from the following: Motor Corps, Hospital Staff, Drum & Bugle Corps, Funsters, Arab Patrol, Car Club, Patrol Ladies, Oriental Band and Joe Wyatt. A tip of the fez to these generous nobles. Funding for this project is still ongoing and we would appreciate any donations from groups and/or individuals.

I hope you are aware, that the key to Hadi's financial success is increasing revenue and reducing costs. Chad Keown, our Arabian Room Manager, is leading the way by managing costs & attracting catering business. Another key reason for our 2009 Arabian Room success has been the work of Rod McDonald and the Arabian Room Committee. I want to personally thank everyone for their hard work and participation this year.

I hope that this gives some insight as to why a Board Member (Divan) may ask for donations from your UCO. Hadi's future is dependent upon all units, clubs and organizations working together by supporting opportunities when they arise. When a Board Member (Divan) asks for your help, please consider the request as an investment into Hadi's future.

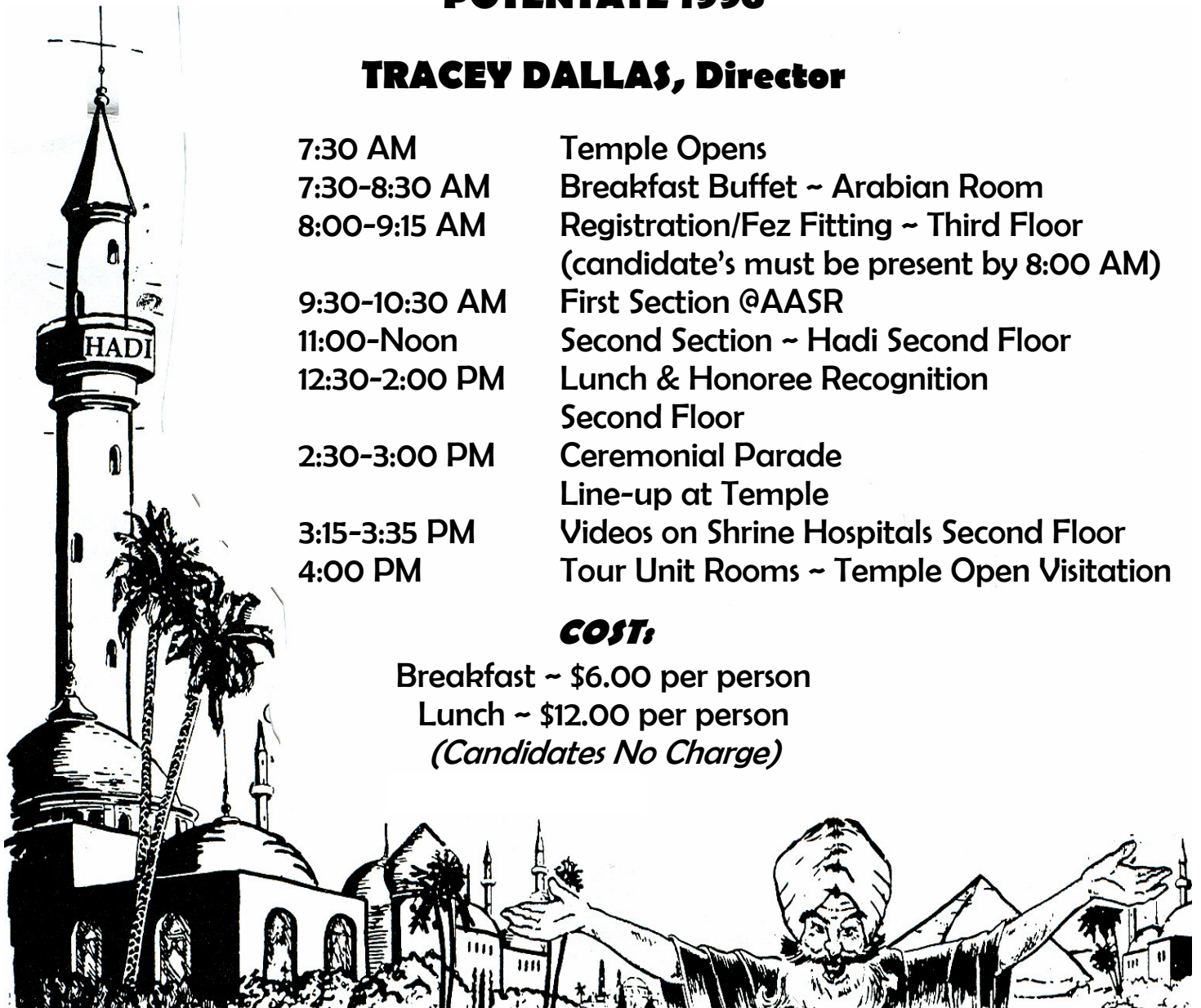
